1. Maren Hassinger, "Fight the Power and Other Tales of Survival" at the Cooper Union

Director of the school of sculpture at Maryland Institute College of Art, artist Maren Hassinger has since the 1970s pursued a practice that spans documentary video, body-based performance, and feminist reclamation of "women's work," often in site-specific fashion. Her work can be found in collections from the Studio Museum in Harlem to the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art.
