

17. "Beverly Semmes: Red" at Susan Inglett Gallery

Susan Inglett is featuring <u>Beverly Semmes</u> at the ADAA Art Show this week—where she'll be giving out signed copies of her zine, Pinky—in conjunction with a solo show of the artist's work at its Chelsea gallery. In Semmes' "Feminist Responsibility Project" series, begun in the early 2000s and on view last year at the 57th Carnegie International in Pittsburgh, she enlarges photographs from 1990s porn magazines. Painting atop the women's nude bodies, Semmes acts as a creative censor, disrupting the gaze.
