In The Community: Celebrate 126 years of the enlightening power of cycling at Susan Inglett Gallery, where curator David Platzker of Specific Object and Alex Ostroy of the cycling apparel brand Ostroy will present *Re: Bicycling* from June 17 to July 13. The exhibition includes a vast range of bicycle-inspired artists and objects, from twentieth-century heavyweight Robert Rauschenberg to contemporary powerhouse Nina Chanel Abney, vintage advertising to interactive sculpture.

In conjunction with the show, Ostroy has designed limited-edition women's and men's cycling jerseys which will be exclusively available at the Gallery and specificobject.com. These jerseys can be worn in style as group rides led by Platzker will depart from the Gallery at 10:30 AM every Wednesday during the run of the show. The round-trip rides will take cyclists up the Hudson River Waterfront Greenway to the Little Red Lighthouse at the base of the George Washington Bridge, returning to the Gallery for refreshments.
