The announcements, posters, and related ephemera in this show were selected by David Platzker, of the gallery Specific Object, from the collection of the bibliophile Jean-Noël Herlin. Together, they offer a lively overview of the conceptual kingpin's prolific career. Since the late sixties, Weiner has realized one poetically cryptic text piece after another, always in the same sans-serif font (in addition to videos and sound works).
