

Critics' picks The five best events this week



1 "Screw You" Susan Inglett

This show revisits a period during the sexual revolution of the late-'60s and early-'70s, when contemporary art and pornography intersected in the pulp pages of softcore tabloids sporting titles like *Screw*, *Kiss* and *Pleasure*. ▶ **Through July 13; see Chelsea**

2 Richard Avedon, "Murals and Portraits" Gagolian Gallery

The 1960s are recalled in these group portraits, in which the figures are life-size. ▶ **Through July 6; see Chelsea**

3 "Art of Another Kind: International Abstraction and the Guggenheim" Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum

This collection show demonstrates that Abstract Expressionism was part of a worldwide transformation of abstract art that took place in the years following World War II. ▶ **Fri 8–Sept 12; see Museums**

4 Ryan McGinness Gering & López Gallery + Charles Bank Gallery

McGinness's twin-space meditation on the female form channels Matisse's late nudes via bathroom signage.
